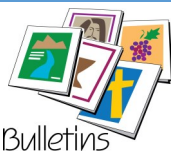

February, 2025: **Todd VanderMay**

Todd VanderMay, 28, is the son of Steve and Vickie VanderMay of Long Valley, SD. He grew up on a ranch in Long Valley. His home parish is Our Lady of the Sacred Heart in Martin.



When asked how he became inspired to discern God's will, he said, "In late high school I had a reversion, and I came to realize there had to be more to life than seeking pleasures. I took a year off after school before college and my pastor gave the vocations office my name and I went along to a seminary visit but did not like it. However, I thought that maybe I could be a decent priest, so I decided to give seminary a try and kept giving to the process and God kept inviting me along for more. Now I'm a year away from ordination." He is currently in the Configuration Stage of formation at St. Paul Seminary.
